CAP. X.

An Act to indemnify the Governor for Sums advanced towards defraying, in part, the Expenses of the Fourth and Fifth Sessions of the Second General Assembly.

[Passed 26th April, 1841]

HEREAS it is necessary to indemnify His Excellency the Gover- Preamble. nor for Sums of Money advanced by him in compliance with an Address of certain Members of the Assembly, towards defraying, in part, the expenses of the Fourth and Fifth Sessions of the Second General Assembly:

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, in Governor indemnified General Assembly convened, that from and out of such Monies as shall for sums advanced for the purposes be and remain in the hands of the Treasurer of this Island, upon the herein recited. passing of this Act, there be granted to Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, the Sum of Four Thousand Five Hundred and Twenty-six Pounds Fifteen Shillings and Five Pence, towards indemnifying the Governor for advances made by him in compliance with an Address of certain Members of the General Assembly of this Island, bearing date the Seventeenth Day of May, in the Third Year of the Reign of Her present Majesty.
