A NEW MODE OF HANGING

No Scaffold, Just a Trap Door and a Prison Cellar.

Concord, N.H., Feb. 18—Oscar J. Comery was hanged at the state prison early today for the murder of his wife. An unusual method of execution was employed. No scaffold was used. Comery was led to a store room and a placid standing on a trap door. The single electric light in the room was extinguished for twenty seconds while the drop was sprung and the body dropped into the prison cellar. The execution was the first in this state in twenty three years.

Both joined in the recent fighting against the British in which the eastern suffered severe losses. 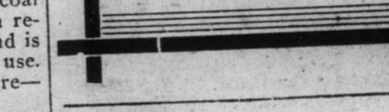
