## THE MARKETS OF TODAY

### LOCAL MARKETS.

London, Thursday, Feb. 9.  
At 10 o'clock this morning the prospects were not very bright for having a market worthy of the name. As all the other markets were not a dozen dollars in the market, there was a number of farmers brought in their produce. The market was the supply of dressed hogs; there were about 15 carcasses of hogs, of which the greater number were just a trifle heavy, and for that reason the holders had to accept lower prices. Sales were made at \$7.50 per cwt. for about two-thirds of the offerings; the remainder sold at \$7.50 and \$7.50 per cwt.

There was not a great deal of poultry offered; there was no change in prices. Hay was not in large supply, as there were only a few loads offered, which sold at \$7.50 and \$7.50 per ton.

A couple of loads of oats were marketed; sales were made at \$1.00 and \$1.00 per cwt. There is a good demand for apples. Apples were scarce this morning, and higher prices were secured at \$1.25 per barrel for the bulk, or 40c to 45c when sold by the bag.

Butchers' Meats—Sales were moderate for the fairly large supply; there was no change in prices.
