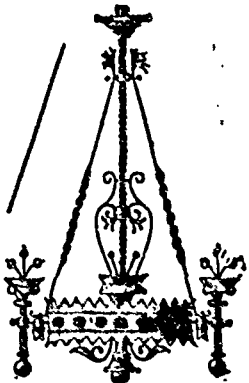

Household Hints.

FEATHER CAKE.—One teaspoonful of sugar, one egg, a piece of butter as big as a butternut, one-half cup of sweet milk, one teaspoonful of baking powder, and one and one-half cups of flour.

APPLE GINGER.—Those who are fond of Chinese preserved ginger. will like the following. Use four pounds of apple cut in inch pieces (some chop it, four pounds of brown sugar, and one fourth pound ginger root; put into one quart of water, and boil till reduced nearly one-half. Then add the sugar, make a hot syrup, then add the apple and boil till clear.

FOR WINTER BREAKFAST.—Something appetizing is apples fried with bacon. Core and slice round, without paring, some tart, well flavoured apples. Cut into thin slices some middlings of excellent bacon or pork, and fry in their own fat almost to crispness. Take out the meat and keep hot while you fry the apples in the fat left in the pan; add a little sugar to taste. Drain and lay upon the slices of meat.

CODDLED EGGS.—The only way to serve eggs in the shell is by this method. Put some water on the fire in a large saucepan, and as soon as it boils hard, remove it to the table and put in the eggs. Let them stand ten minutes (six minutes will suffice if the kettle is kept covered), and at the end of that time they will be perfectly cooked, white and yolk equally, and, particularly if daten from the shell, they will be found delicious.
