TO CAN STRAWBERRIES.—Pick over the berries carefully to insure the absence of any decayed or worm-eaten ones. Put them in a granite or porcelain-lined kettle with enough sugar to sweeten to taste, about one-quarter of a pound to a pound of berries; set on the back of the stove or where they will boil slowly for a few minutes. When cooked, can immediately in self-sealing cans. After the fruit is cold, screw the lids a little tighter, or open and fill full again with hot cooked fruit and seal tight.

OATMEAL WATER.—This is the cheapest and one of the most healthful hot weather drinks. It is simply oatmeal stirred into cold water, and allowed to settle before drinking. This is sold in New York at a penny a glass, giving the venter about ninety-nine per cent. of profit. It makes a pleasanter drink if a very thin gruel is made, using one tablespoonful of oatmeal to a quart of water. Boil for an hour, strain, and let it get very cold. Still another improvement is to add the juice of one lemon, and two tablespoonfuls of sugar to each quart.

CRAB SOUPS.—Boil one dozen crabs and pick out the meat. Put four ounces of butter in a frying pan, add to it one large onion, sliced. Cook until the onion is a golden brown, then add the crab meat and four ounces of tomatoes, sliced; cover the frying pan and stand it on the back part of the stove, to cook slowly for thirty minutes. Do not use an iron frying pan, or the delicate flavour of the soup will be destroyed. Put one pint of stock, and one pint of milk in a farina boiler, add to it a bay leaf and a sprig of parsley. When the ingredients in the frying-pan are tender, press them through a colander, and add to milk in farina boiler. Moisten two tablespoonfuls of corn starch in a little cold milk, add it to the contents of the farina boiler, stir continually until it thickens, season highly with salt and pepper, and serve very hot.

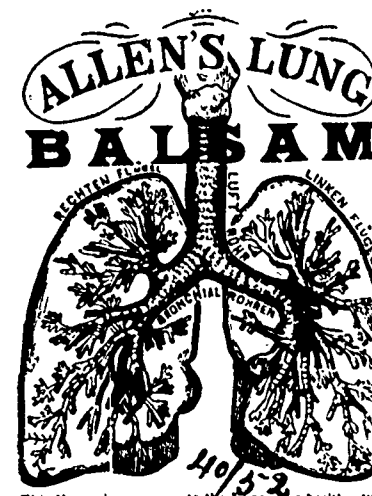
A SOLEMN VOW.

LEMONADE.—This summer drink is economical if the opportunity of making a lemon syrup is seized when lemons are cheap. Grate the thin yellow rind of twelve large lemons over six pounds of granulated sugar. Add two quarts of water, and stir over the fire until the sugar is dissolved. Bring to a boil and boil until it thickens, skimming as fast as the scum rises. Add the juice of the twelve lemons and simmer fifteen minutes longer. Bottle and cork tightly, and keep in a cool place. Two tablespoonfuls of this syrup will make a delicious glass of lemonade. We must agree with trippers that the lemonade of church fairs is usually not a "nice drink." But if you will rub the rind of a lemon with a lump of cut sugar, extract the juice of half a lemon with a squeezer that will keep out the pulp and seeds, fill up the glass with cold water, and a strawberry, two or three luscious blackberries or a stem of currants, and will further furnish it with two straws, you will have a drink pleasing to both eye and palate. Lemonade made as above, substituting tea, weak or strong, according to taste, for water, is both stimulating and refreshing.
