Dr. McGilchrist, one by the late Rev. D. M. Inglis, of Stockbridge, one by Rev. Dr. Kerr of Glasgow, and one by Rev. Dr. Cairns of Berwick-on-Tweed. An excellent sermon by the Rev. Peter Mearns, of Coldstream, closes the volume.

**SOWING THE GOOD SEED: THE OLD AND THE NEW HOME.**—These are two additional numbers of the Canadian Prize Sunday School Books, published by James Campbell & Son, Toronto. Like the first of the series, which we noticed some time ago, they may be said to be, both in matter and style of getting up, far before most of the books issued for Sabbath Schools. We doubt not they will have a place in most Sabbath School libraries in the Dominion of Canada.
