Leif Pagrotsky Minister for Trade and Nordic Co-operation

Leif Pagrotsky was born on October 20, 1951, in Göteborg. He obtained a bachelor of arts degree from Göteborg University in 1971 and graduated with a master's degree in business administration and science in 1974.

Mr. Pagrotsky has had assignments with the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development and the European Investment Bank, as well as memberships on boards of directors of state-owned companies.
