The Department of External Affairs announced that Mr. Ove Flemming de Sehested presented today to the Deputy Governor General, the Honourable Mr. Justice P. Kerwin, at the Supreme Court of Canada Building, his Letter of Credence as Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary of Denmark to Canada.

The Deputy Governor General was attended by the Secretary to the Governor General (Administrative), Mr. J.F. Delaute, and Superintendant C.N.K. Kirk, Honorary Aide-de-Camp to the Governor General.

The Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs, Mr. L.D. Wilgress, was present. Mr. H.F. Feaver, Head of the Protocol Division, presented Mr. Sehested to the Deputy Governor General. The Minister was accompanied by Mr. Anker Svart, Secretary of the Legation.

Mr. Sehested was born in 1888. He entered the Danish Foreign Service in 1912 and has served in a number of capitals including Paris, Stockholm, Berne, Prague and Oslo. He was Minister of Denmark to Brazil from 1835 to 1947 and has since served in the Foreign Ministry at Copenhagen.
