## **RESOLUTION 56.**

## A Resolution for the relief of Mary Margaret Fraser MacDonald.

## [Adopted 8th October, 1968.]

WHEREAS Mary Margaret Fraser MacDonald, residing at the city of Laval, in the province of Quebec, wife of Donald Lamont MacDonald, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at the city of LaSalle, in the said province, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the twentyfourth day of April, A.D. 1948, at the city of Vancouver, in the province of British Columbia, she then being Mary Margaret Fraser; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, on the ground of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have been proved by evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore the Senate of Canada, pursuant to the provisions of the DISSOLUTION AND ANNULMENT OF MARRIAGES ACT and subject to section 2 thereof, resolves as follows:—

**1.** On the expiration of thirty days from the date of the adoption by the Senate of this resolution, the said marriage shall be dissolved and thenceforth shall be null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever.
