375. Fraser river—50 per cent of cost of investigations to be carried out by the dominion-provincial board Fraser river basin, \$85,000.

376. Protection works generally—to provide for remedial works where damages are caused by, or endanger, navigation or federal government structures, \$500,000.

377. National Gallery of Canada, \$186,785.

378. Miscellaneous works not otherwise provided for, not more than \$5,000 to be expended upon any one work, \$300,000.

379. To supplement, on approval of treasury board except where less than \$500 is required, any of the appropriations of the Department of Public Works \$300,000.

380. To provide for balances required to complete any projects undertaken in previous fiscal years and for which no specific provision is made in the fiscal year 1949-50, \$100,000.

Architectural branch—

704. Maintenance and operation of dominion public buildings and grounds, other than at Ottawa including rents, repairs, furniture, heating, etc.—further amount required, \$1,000,000.

Construction, repairs and improvements of public buildings—Newfoundland—

705. Dominion public buildings—construction, purchase, repairs and improvements, \$750,000.
