producers by the processing plants. This question comes under provincial jurisdiction as concerns milk, and I insisted in my statement on the fact that producers associations and marketing boards should do everything in their power to secure a fair price.

When the dairy commission is instituted, it is expected that each province will set up its own milk control, responsible for setting the price of milk. For instance, the Ontario Dairy Board has already set a price of \$3.25 per

hundredweight which, combined with the federal subsidy of 75 cents, gives the producer a price of \$4 per hundredweight of milk.

In the casein producing areas, I am given to understand that low prices on world markets are creating difficulties. The Agricultural Stabilization Board is currently considering this situation in order to remedy the problem.

Motion agreed to and the house adjourned at 10.23 p.m.
