And the question being put on the said motion it was agreed to.

A Message was received from the Senate informing this House that the Senate had passed the Bill No. 222, An Act to amend The Canadian Red Cross Society Act, with amendments, which are as follows:—

- 1. Page 1, lines 4 to 7, both inclusive: Strike out clause 1.
- 2. Page 1, lines 8 to 23, both inclusives: Strike out clause 2.
- 3. Page 1: Re-number clause 3 to read clause 1.
