casualty—kăzh'u-al-te. See accurate.

căt-a-ma-răñ'.

Incorrectly marked in the old editions of Worcester, că-tăm'a-răñ'.

Cău-că-siān, *not* kău-kă'zhăñ.

că've-ăt, *not* kăv'.

ce-răm'ic, or ke-răm'ic.

chăr'y, *not* chă'y.

chiaro oscuro (It.)—kē-ä'rō ös-kü'rō.

cli-măt'ic.

The vowel *i* is often long in the initial syllables *i*, *bi*, *chi*, *cli*, *pri*, *tri*, though not under the accent, as in *ideal*, *biography*, *chirology*, *climatic*, *primeval*, *tribunal*, etc.

cõm-măñ-dăñt' (Fr.).

The pronunciation of this word is a compromise between the French and the English.

coquetry—kō-kĕt're.

dÿ'n'äm-ite, *not* di'näm-ite.

elongate—e-lõng'gät.
