că-și'nô (It.)—*a little house.*

casualty—kăzh'u-ăl-te. See accurate.

căt-a-mă-răn'.

Incorrectly marked in the old editions of Worcester, ca-tăm'a-răn.

Cău-că'sian, *not* kău-kă'zhan.

că've-ăt, *not* kăv'.

ce-răm'ic, *or* ke-răm'ic.

chăr'y, *not* chă'ry.

chiaro oscuro (It.)—kē-ă-rô ôs-ku'rô.

cli-măt'ic.

The vowel *i* is often long in the initial syllables *i*, *bi*, *chi*, *cli*, *pri*, *tri*, though not under the accent, as in *ideal*, *biography*, *chirology*, *climatic*, *primeval*, *tribunal*, etc.

côm-măn-dănt' (Fr.).

The pronunciation of this word is a compromise between the French and the English.

coquetry—kô-kět're.

dŷn'ăm-ite, *not* dī'năm-ite.

elongate—e-lông'găt.

*N*, ending an accented syllable before *g*, *k*,
