



How to Get to Abenakis Springs

From Montreal by rail. Take the Grand Trunk Railway train leaving Bonaventure Station, which connects with the Quebec, Montreal & Southern at St. Lambert. Two trains daily.

From points in Canada, East, South and West of Montreal, Abenakis Springs can be reached via the Grand Trunk, Intercolonial and Canadian Pacific railways, which make connection at junction points with the Quebec, Montreal & Southern Railway for the Springs.

From Boston and points in New England, Abenakis Springs can be reached by the Rutland, Boston & Maine and Central Vermont railways, the principal trains of which make close connection at junction points with the Grand Trunk and Quebec, Montreal & Southern for the Springs.

From New York City and State, Abenakis Springs can be reached by the Rutland, New York Central and Delaware & Hudson railways, the principal trains of which make close connection with the Grand Trunk and Quebec, Montreal & Southern for the Springs.

From all points in the United States, South and West of New York, the Springs is reached via the New York Central & Hudson River, Pennsylvania and Baltimore & Ohio railroads and their connections.
