No sale of lands suitable for muskrat farming. Plan of survey.

5. (1) No territorial lands suitable for muskrat farming shall be sold.

(2) No territorial lands shall be sold until a plan of survey thereof has been approved by the Surveyor General.

Limitation on sale.

6. (1) Not more than one hundred and sixty acres of territorial lands may be sold to any one person without the approval of the Governor in Council.

Limitation on lease.

(2) Subject to subsection three, not more than six hundred and forty acres of territorial lands may be leased to any one person without the approval of the Governor in Council.

Limitation on lease of hay lands.

(3) Where territorial lands are hav lands or lands suitable for grazing or muskrat farming, not more than six thousand four hundred acres may be leased to any one person without the approval of the Governor in Council.

7. The Governor in Council may make regulations for 15 mining rights. the leasing of mining rights in, under or upon territorial lands and the payment of royalties therefor, but such regulations shall provide for the protection of and compensation to the holders of surface rights.
