on receipt of the price of the card. Members may apply in person, or by letter, for such cards. Should objection be offered for cause the Lodge may suspend issue of the card until an investigation is held. Visiting Cards shall be granted upon application in open Lodge, or they may be issued by the Noble Grand and Recording Secretary as members in good standing upon application in writing, but in either case the dues of the applicant must be paid up to the end of the time for which the card is granted, whic! time shall not exceed one year from the date of the card. A member suspended from membership for non-payment of dues shall be granted on application a Dismissal Certificate on the payment of one dollar without fir t applying for reinstatement. No ballot is required in granting a Dismissal Certificate.
