THE TORTURES AT BARCELONA.

Anarchists' Nails Were Torn Off, They Were Fed on Salt Fish Without Water and Their Bodies Were Terribly Beaten.

The cry of the assassin, Goll, "I have done my duty and avenged my brothers of Barcelona," brings to mind the severity of Signor Canovas in dealing with more than 400 suspected persons and the unspeakable tortures they suffered.

For the throwing of the bomb into a church procession at Barcelona on June 7, 1886, which it is now generally understood was the work of two or three accomplices, 400 persons of all shades of advanced opinion, members of workmen's clubs, Republicans, Radicals and Socialists were accused of complicity.

One of the prisoners named Nogues, manager of the newspaper "El Tribuna," which he said: "I would not bear the atrocious tortures of so many days. On my arrival I was obliged to eat salt fish and drink, obliged to walk continually to and fro, and to sleep on a hard floor.

Imagine the terrible aspect of such a place, with two or three civil guards following and one going in front to open the door and let in the accused.

Good night, right-feeding people, do not let your attention be diverted from this. I have said, and I repeat, that I do not know where the good work which you did by making my martyrdom a public affair.
