

THURSDAY, July 4th, 187

The Synod met pursuant to adjournment,—the Lord Bishop took the Chair.

Prayers.

The roll of the Clergy and Lay Representatives was called by the Secretary, and the attendance marked.

The minutes of the meeting of yesterday having been read, a motion of Mr. James R. Ruel, seconded by the Rev. Canon Lee, the same were approved.

The discussion on the resolution offered yesterday by Mr. Jarvis, relative to union with the Provincial Synod of Canada, was then resumed; whereupon it was moved by the Rev. E. Tippet, seconded by the Rev. Canon Lee, and

Resolved, That Mr. Jarvis be permitted, by leave of the Synod, to withdraw his resolution.

The resolution was accordingly withdrawn.

On motion of Mr. W. M. Jarvis, seconded by the Rev. Canon Lee,

Resolved, That the Committee appointed to consider the question relative to the Provincial Synod of Canada be continued and enlarged—to consist of the Bishop with five clerical and lay members of the Synod, and be requested to further report on those questions at the next meeting of the Synod.

“That the Committee be also requested to publish the information they may obtain respecting such questions at a period as possible, in order that the matter may be fully considered before the meeting of the Synod;”
