



A "wind-rose" was charted and showed that 76 per cent of the cinder emitted from the stacks is blown into the river, due to the prevailing winds from the northwest. The other portion represents the area within which the remaining 24 per cent of the cinder was distributed. This rose shows that less than one-quarter of the cinder emitted was deposited in an area from which complaints came. This fact indicates what a large amount was blown from the stacks, when less than one-quarter of it caused the protests that have been made. It is from a study of this wind rose, perhaps, that one can best appreciate how serious this cinder problem really is, or rather was; since a successful catcher has been devised.
