

Mayor Suggests Social Worker as Chief of Police

Chicago, Oct. 31—That Chicago may have a woman chief of police became known when Mapor Harrison said he was thinking of the fitness of a good woan for the general superintendency of police. Mrs. Gertrude Howe Britton, superintendent of the Juvenile Protection Association, a prominent social worker, is the woman the mayor has in mind, and, with her appointment two of the most powerful appointive positions in the Windy City would be filled by women, as Mrs. Ella Flagg Young is superintendent of Chicago, who has filled the office four times, looking ahead to the next municipal election when the women of Chicago, will be allowed to vote for city offices? 
