### PIONEER BAPTIST MISSIONARY DEAD

Rev. John R. McLaughlin, one of the best known foreign missionaries in Canada, died last week at late residence in Toronto. He was 73 years old, and was one of the pioneer Baptist missionaries in India. Mr. McLaughlin was born in Osgoode, Carlton county, in 1839, and educated at Woodstock College, after which he took up a pastorate in Strathroy. In 1880 he went to India under the auspices of the American Baptist mission. He established the Lone Star mission, and labored in the great revival of Osgoode in 1874. In 1876 he established the first Canadian Baptist mission in Teluk country, India, and for many years occupied his work in that part of India. Four years ago his health broke down and he returned to Toronto, after having spent forty years in India. He leaves his wife, one son, Rev. J. M. McLaughlin, also a missionary in India, and three daughters.
