This treaty, of which the text is printed at the close of Mr. Blaine's dispatch, does not contain a word to signify the acquiescence of Great Britain in the claim recently put forward by Russia to control the waters of the sea for 100 miles from her coast. There is no stipulation upon which this interpretation can be imposed by any process of construction whatever.

It is now quite clear that the advisers of the President do not claim Behring sea as a mare clausum, and indeed that they repudiate that contention in express terms.

Nor do they rely, as a justification for the seizure of British ships in the open sea, upon the contention that the interests of the seal fisheries give to the United States government any right for that purpose, which, according to international law it would not otherwise possess.
