BEHINDING SEA DEPUTE NARROWED DOWN. England Accepts Most of the Propositions, But Claims That the Sea is Part of the Pacific. To Treaty of Commerce and Navigation—She Has Always Denied the Usage of 1821.

WASHINGTON, D. C., March 10. The Behring sea negotiations have taken a most favorable turn, and the governments of the United States and Great Britain appear to have at length reached a basis upon which to settle their difficulties. This is shown by the following communication from Lord Salisbury to Sir Julian Pauncefote, the British minister here, which was laid before Secretary Blaine and was made public by him tonight.
