Students resident in Montreal may share in the Bursary Fund, on producing certificates from their ministers or clergymen that such aid is absolutely necessary to their continuing in attendance at the School.

In addition to religious instruction of a general Protestant character by the Professors, arrangements will be made for special religious instruction by ministers representing the several denominations with which the Students may be connected.

No boarding-house is attached to the institution, but every carewill be taken to ensure the comfort and good conduct of the Studentsin private boarding-houses approved by the Principal. Board can be obtained at from \$12 to \$16 per month.

The J. C. Wilson Frize of \$40 and a Book, contributed by him as a former Student of the School, will be offered for competition to the candidates for the Elementary Diploma, and will be given for the highest aggregate number of marks.

The Prince of Wales Medal and Prize will be given to the student taking the highest place in the Model School Class, provided that such student shall attain to the standard fixed by the Regulation of the Council of Public Instruction for this Medal.

The Marquis of Lonsdowne Medal will be given to the student taking the highest place in the Academy class.

It has been resolved by the McGill and Bishop's Universities and by St Francis College, Richmond, to accept the Academy course in the Normal School as the equivalent of the first year in their Faculties of Arts on certain equitable conditions, so that all who have passed satisfactorily through that course are entitled to enter the second year of the courses in Arts without further examination. The McGill University also offers free tuition in the Faculty of Arts in the second year to such students of the Academy Class, not exceeding three in number, as at the final examinations take 75 per cent. of the total marks, with not less than two-thirds of the marks in Latin and in Greek.
