ONE WEEK LATER FROM EUROPE

London, Monday August 11. The "Canada" which left Liverpool at 10 on the morning of Saturday, the 2nd inst., arrived at Halifax at half past four, at 10 on the 11th.

The Kangaroo and Anglo Saxon sailed from Liverpool, and the Arago from Southampton on Wednesday the 20th. The Baltic arrived on the morning of the 20th. The North America from Quebec arrived at Liverpool on the 31st.

The Queen reviewed 20,000 troops at Aldershot camp on the 31st July. A Gall (Chronometer) was presented by the President of the United States through the medium of the marine Board of Liverpool, to Captain (Clarke) of the ship *Bacocha* for having rescued the crew of the American ship *Mayflower*.

A Liverpool jobber has given a verdict of Manly against the Pilot and mate of the steam ship *Excelsior* in the recent fall collision with the steam *Mail*, in the Mersey. General Cadrington arrived in London on the night of the 1st inst.

The citizens of Sheffield gave a banquet to Lord Cardigan and the 4th Dragoon guards. The Indian Mail brings accounts of an earthquake in the Malacca on the 2nd of March, which made the loss of two thousand lives.

The Monitor promulgates various Bills passed during the late session, among them the Bill of the Orleans pension. From Marseilles Friday last, we hear that Marshal Pelissier had arrived on board the *Island*. He was received with great pomp; a banquet to his honour will take place on Sunday the 3rd.

The French funds closed on Friday the 1st at Paris as follows—3 per cent 70 of 20. 4 1/2 per cent 95. 50. SPAIN. Accounts continue uncertain but there are indications that the entire country has submitted and that Saragossa, unsupported, will be immediately reduced.

The London Morning Post publishes the following despatch from Madrid, dated July 29th: "All the provinces are tranquil, Saragossa accepted, it is thought that the majority in the city will be disposed to capitulate; the resistance of some chiefs only is anticipated. Generals Echaguen and Dulcio are before Saragossa, and reinforcements are arriving from all sides."
