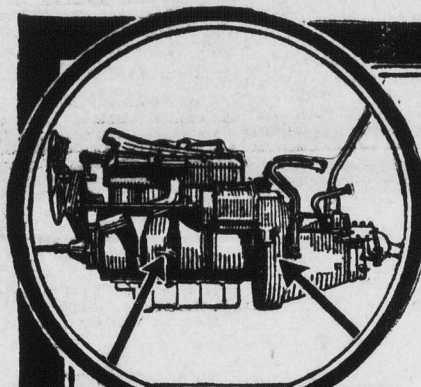

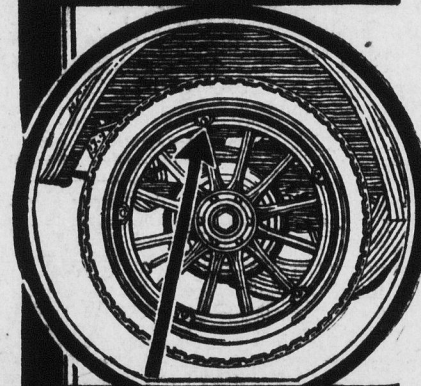

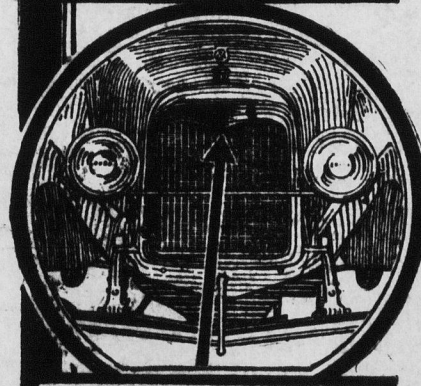

4-cylinder Unit Power Plant with enclosed fly-wheel and clutch.



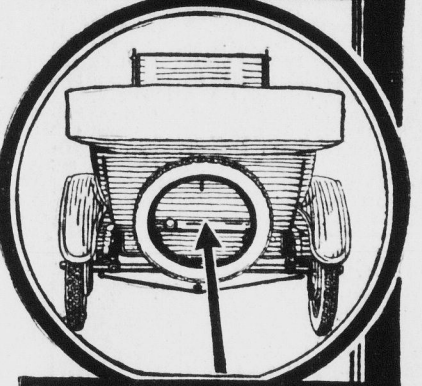
Demountable Rims are regular equipment of the 1916 Maxwell.
