

LEITH Reg. No. 13707, ex-Cst. Sidney Samuel Leith, 84, died November 19, 1997, at Abbotsford, B.C. He was born March 26, 1913, at Saskatoon, Sask., and joined the Force September 4, 1940, at Calgary, Alta. Upon completion of training at "Depot," Leith was posted to "D" Division, Man., namely at Dauphin, The Pas and Cold Lake, where he took his discharge on September 3, 1945.

Leith served as Provincial Court Judge, in British Columbia, from 1955 to 1973.

MADILL Reg. No. 21645, ex-Cst. Victor Keith Madill, 57, died in July 1997, in Manitoba. He was born September 10, 1940, at Winnipeg, where he joined the Force November 4, 1960. Upon completion of training at "Depot," Madill was posted to "E" Division, B.C., namely at Kelowna and Kamloops, where he took his discharge on March 1, 1965.

MATTE Reg. No. 27168, Sgt. Joseph Roméo Normand Matte, 49, died October 26, 1997, at Boucherville, Que. He was born October 17, 1948, at Trois-Rivières, and joined the Force March 4, 1969, at Quebec City. Upon completion of training at "Depot," Matte was posted to "C" Division, Que., namely at Sherbrooke, Dorval, Quebec City and Montréal, where he was still serving at the time of his death. He was promoted to corporal February 1, 1977; sergeant May 27, 1991.

MAYNARD Reg. No. C/2635, C/M Walter Luther Maynard, 55, died August 20, 1997, at Springbrook, Alta. He was born February 14, 1942, at Tracy, N.B., and joined the Force as a civilian member January 2, 1980, at Calgary. Maynard was posted to "K" Division, Alta., namely at Calgary and Red Deer, where he was still serving at the time of his death.

Maynard served with the Canadian Armed Forces, from August 1958 to November 1978.

MILLER Reg. No. O.431 (12770), C/Supt. George Henry Miller (retired), 86, died October 7, 1997, at Gloucester, Ont. He was born August 12, 1911, at Lipton, Sask., and joined the Force July 8, 1935, at Regina. Upon completion of training at "Depot," Miller was posted to "D" Division, Man., where he served at Winnipeg, Dauphin, Shoal Lake, Roblin and Headingley. He was subsequently transferred to the following locations: May 10, 1948, to "A" Division, Ont., at Ottawa; January 4, 1952, to "O" Division, Ont., at Toronto; September 1, 1959, to RCMP HQ, namely with Visa Control in Cologne, Germany, and in Ottawa; July 1, 1963, to "C"

Division, Que., at Montréal; September 1, 1965, to "D" Division, at Winnipeg; October 10, 1967, to "H" Division, N.S., at Halifax, where he was appointed Commanding Officer, and then retired on July 8, 1970. Miller was promoted to corporal November 1, 1945; sergeant October 1, 1949; sub-inspector November 1, 1951; inspector November 1, 1953; superintendent May 1, 1962, chief superintendent October 1, 1967.

NEWPORT Reg. No. 13299, ex-S/S/M Aubrey Herbert Mead Newport, 84, died November 21, 1997, at Winnipeg, Man. He was born October 20, 1913, at Newport, Wales, and joined the Force March 23, 1940, at Halifax, N.S. Upon completion of training at "Depot" and "N" Divisions, Newport was posted to "H" Division, N.S., namely at Halifax and Sheet Harbour. He was subsequently transferred to the following locations: September 27, 1950, to "A" Division, Ont., at Ottawa; April 1, 1952, to RCMP HQ; November 1, 1958, to "D" Division, Man., at Winnipeg, where he retired on January 17, 1966. Newport was promoted to corporal May 1, 1948; sergeant November 1, 1952; staff sergeant May 1, 1955; staff sergeant major May 1, 1961.

PALMER Reg. No. 13738, ex-Cst. Lloyd John James Palmer, 77, died June 5, 1997, at Winnipeg, where he was born June 16, 1919, and joined the Force November 8, 1940. Upon completion of training at "Depot" and "N" Divisions, he was posted to "A" Division, Ont., where he worked at Ottawa. On July 7, 1942, Palmer was transferred to "N" Division, and then on September 18, 1942, he was posted to "L" Division, P.E.I., namely at Charlottetown, Borden and Alberton, taking his discharge on June 30, 1945.

PHILLIPS Reg. No. 13440, ex-S/Sgt. Llewellyn Lloyd Phillips, 83, died December 28, 1997, at Lac la Biche, Alta. He was born June 8, 1914, at Thornhill, Man., and joined the Force May 27, 1940, at Regina. Upon completion of training at "Depot," Phillips was posted to "K" Division, Alta., where he worked at Edmonton, Vermilion, Bonnyville, St. Albert, Lac la Biche, Stony Plain and Red Deer, retiring on March 12, 1964. He was promoted to corporal January 1, 1951; sergeant November 1, 1958; staff sergeant May 1, 1961.

PIERCE Reg. No. 13236 (R/233), ex-Cst. Frank Lawrence Pierce, 79, died May 26, 1997, at Duncan, B.C. He was born June 6,
