He was accompanied by ten of the grocers, and the argument put before the board was that Dr. McFall as Cost of Living Commissioner had no right to cancel the contract.

The contract called for a 2¢ cent per tin rebate on all goods ordered by the grocers from the canners 12 months ahead.
