Mr. CHAMBERLAIN to the EARL OF ABERDEEN.

My LORD, Downing Street, April 9, 1896.

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your Lordship's despatch of the 29th February, forwarding an address to Her Majesty the Queen from the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario expressing the unalterable loyalty and devotion
