1881

5. MONDAY. [107-208]

Had rather fine to day James got home he brought a bag of Potatoes we were all awful busy putting out a fine that got in the dung pile at the stable. It was Charming around and watching the fine had a half breed fencing I went off to the post some Indians asked me to go when they were getting some goods from Scott & they wanted me to be present.

6. TUESDAY. [108-207]

fine day I hired a horse and went around to Beardys & Thomas Reserves they are doing well. James was blowing & harrowing so is very sick. Had to Indians fencing old white Cap came in this evening.

7. WEDNESDAY. [109-206]

fine day James was harrowing barley. It is very sick. Had two men fencing old white left for home I have two bushels of barley showed one arrow. Councillor came to have a sawow.

8. THURSDAY. [100-205]

fine day I went down to the River but could not get across the water is very high and Fisher had no help. James Halling sails till now he was fencing in the afternoon I sent my boys to Beardy and borrowed one from the mill. It is very sick had one Indian fencing.

9. FRIDAY. [101-204]

very fine day James was Halling rails & pickets. Had four men fencing. Joe is better he has planted some Cabbage this evening. The weather is awful warm this week.

10. SATURDAY. [102-203]

fine day Had 3 men fencing. James was harrowing rails & pickets. It was planting Cabbage I walked all over Beardys Reserve. Peter came home he has finished with one arrow they have all sowed barley with finish next week.

11. TRINITY SUNDAY. [103-202]

A fine day I went to Carlton after some medicine for one of Beardys sick oxen I could not get any. The ox died if I could have got any I should have saved the ox's life. I believe I could have saved the ox's life.

12. MONDAY. [104-201]

Sent Pete up to Beardys to give them their daily ration. Brinkman and myself were laying the foundation of a kitchen. Had two Indians fencing. James was blowing heavy rain in the afternoon. Gave some strange Indians some grub. Gave 3 meals.

13. TUESDAY. [105-200]

fine day had 2 Indian fencing until noon James was harrowing barley until noon he was helping Brinkman and me in the afternoon building a kitchen. Brinkman was at Beardys in fore noon he was sowing turnips. Pete started for Indian to day.

14. WEDNESDAY. [106-199]

I went up with Brinkman to Beardys this morning we took up 3 oxen they were doing nothing I started them. After I sent James up with the horses after dinner Brinkman and myself were working after kitchen. Pained some I was showing around the house.

15. THURSDAY. [107-198]

Harmed some I sent Brinkman with the team to Beardys they finished. James was helping me at the kitchen. It is still sick although he is working. Beardy sowed 20 bushels of barley to day.

16. FRIDAY. [108-197]

fine day rather cold the I.C. was here he had a sawow with one arrow he gave Crow 2 of my oxen James then harrowed whiffletree. Sent James with a load of I.C. stuff from Stobarts Eden & Co. Small Lake. He brought 300 of flour & 20 lbs of butter. Brinkman at the kitchen. Game & meals.

17. SATURDAY. [109-196]

fine day I took Brinkman for potatoes we went all over Thomas Reserve and measured all his fine and land counted every thing James was harrowing potatoes. It was helping him Brinkman with quit work to night I had to discharge him by order of the I.C. Game & meals.

18. SUNDAY. [1 after Trinity. [170-195]

very cold and cloudy. Old Jack Senath came in.
