The house of representatives passed a resolution, affording a committee to conduct

an investigation into the sweating system in the United States.

On March 17, 1892, the resolution was followed.

The committee met on March 17, 1892, and appointed a subcommittee which was given power of carrying on the investigation throughout the year and on January 20, 1893, the report was laid on the table and ordered

to be printed. At the time of the meeting information was sent to this Washington Committee of the City of the non-members Bureau, containing returns obtained by a special agent of the Bureau from wholesale & retail dealers & contractors carrying on clothing business in the city of Boston, the return concern
