



Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 9th instant, with which you forwarded your travelling expense account from September 1st 1908 to January 1st 1909; and in reply I return the same herewith, in order that you may attach thereto the receipts for payments for horse hire and all hotel expenses. Any receipts which you may have for payments made at hotels should show the number of meals taken. It is not sufficient to furnish only receipts for payment over ~~the~~ one dollar. There should be no limit in that respect. The Department has no wish to withhold payment for fair charges, but at the same time requires to receive full evidence of all expenditure made.
