Re: Indians taking Treaty in 1876

A search was made of the Treaty Annuity payroll for 1876 and the names most closely resembling those requested are:

1. Hec-pac-tah-ahs-cow, whose chief was Ah-takk-ah-hoop, a Cree.
2. Pa-twa-wa-akum, whose chief was Ah-ma-wis-tah-wasit, or Beardy.
3. Fec-ya-see of the Sweet Grass Band, and also Fec-ya-siis, the Chief of the Lac La Riche Band.
