In reply to your last letter in connection with the account that you sent for the half section 17 - 45 - 18, third meridian, I find that your statements are in contradiction to the new agreement that I signed on the 1st of October, 1918, and I have to inform you that I did not buy any land with interest at 7 per cent on the Moccasin and Thunderchild reserves. They were sold with interest at 8 per cent, and further, in 1914 and 1915 I paid the interest, and further, I signed on the 1st day of October an agreement for \$2,582.30, and then I paid \$1,105.00 and there remained on Nov. 5, 1918, \$2,182.30. If you will consult the agreement that I signed, you will find that the amount is as I have told you.
