
Ottawa, May 6, 1919.

Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd ultimo, and to inform you that on the receipt of the sum of \$36.53, being the price of the block containing 1.41 acres at \$33.00 per acre, in the fractional South West quarter of section 3, Tp. 30, R. 31, W. 1 M. in the Cote Indian Reserve, on which your power house is located, a patent for the land will be issued to the Corporation of the Town of Kamsack.

It is not intended to take any steps to close the road allowance provided across the said quarter section, along the East bank of the river.
