With reference to your memorandum of June 24th, file 23165-22, relevant to the highway right-of-way in Boston Bar Indian Reserve No. 2 (Kopchitchin), the returns of this survey have been examined and the plan of survey has been recorded under number Rd. 2917.

A description of the required land, for insertion in the Order-in-Council transferring the land to the Province, is enclosed.

This reserve lies in the former Railway Belt and the question whether the Province should pay compensation for the land required for a road again arises; it is similar to the case relevant to the road across Ohamil Indian Reserve which you recently referred to the Legal Adviser of this Department. When this question has been definitely settled, we will be pleased to draw up the necessary memorandum to Council for the transfer of the road.
