Q. Do you know the lot on the east side of the river, occupied or owned at the time of the transfer, or about then by Adam Cochran? A. Yes.

Q. Is that the Adam Cochran that you mentioned in your evidence this morning? A. A brother.

Q. Did Adam Cochrans lot lie to the south or north of Alexander Cochrans?

A. Adams lot is north of Alexanders lot.

Q. Which was the northerly lot of these two.Adams or Alexanders? A. Adam is living just now at the present time on the north of Alexander Cochran, but he owned the lot on the south side formerly, you see.
