Third Witness The Defence

Brigadier Sasil WEDD, CES, DSO, NE, HD (Massey Marris & Co., Paris, France) be duly sworn, is examined by the Counsel for the Defence:-

Q.1259 I think you filled the appointment of Director Military Covernment and Civil Affairs with Headquarters, lat Canadian Army? A.1259 That's right.

C.1260 That is during the period while the Army was in Northwest Surope? A.1260 That's right.

Q.1261 And I think you remained with the Army right up until the time that General Grear went back to Genada taking you with him? A.1261 That is so.

0.1262 Which would be the middle of July, 1945? A.1262 Soth July, 1945.

Q.1865 During the whole of that period and perhaps possibly before, did you know Brig. Mater?

0.1864 and I think, in fact, you have known him personally since 1940? A.1864 That is so.

4.1265 Now perhaps you will tell us your view as to his character and position and so on?
A.1265 Yes. I have always found him a most conscientious and straightforward officer, and efficient.

Q.1286 And an officient officer. Now, I don't know if you have been told the nature of the charges?
A.1266 No. I man't. I know nothing.

Q.1267 Brig. Wedd, I should tell you to assist you in what you have to say. He has been charged with three charges of conduct to the prejudice of good order and military discipline in that he improperly used for his own private purposes a house in Amsterdam which was requisitioned by the Camadian Army for official purposes. That is one charge, and the other two are commetted with improperly using public preperty, which is food and coal, delivered to that house, and finally, improperly using Dutch civilians at that house, Well, now, Prig. Wedd, those charges having been brought in those circumstances, perhaps it might be of assistance if you could give the picture with regard to requisitioning in Holland and usage of requisitioned property at that time.
