I am K.11008 Sergeant Sullivan, E. Royal Canadian Artillery on the strengt of No.1 Canadian Non-Effective Transit Depot (2 Incr). I am a general duty sergeant at 1 Cdn N.E.T.D. (2 Incr) of which one of my duties is to call the roll on all parades other than Muster Parades. On the 6th September 1944 at 1600 hrs I made a check of personnel in camp and found the accused A.57335 Corporal Moon, J.A. was not in billets nor was he on duty or on pass. After making a check of the camp I then placed him on the absentee report absent as of 1600 hrs 6th September 1944.

B. Sulluran. K.11006 Sergeant Sullivan, B.

The accused declines to cross-oxamine the witness.

Second Witness for the Prosecution B.77345 Corporal Lamble, R.D. of the Lorne Scots Regiment on the strength of 1 Canadian Non-Effective Transit Depot (2 Inor) having been duly sworn states:

I am B.77345 Corporal Lamble, R.D. of the Lorne Socts Regiment on the strength of No.1 Canadian Non-Effective Transit Depot (2 Inor). I am on the Regimental Police at 1 Odn N.E.T.D. (2 Inor) in part charge of the Guard Room. On 25th September 1944 at 1800 hrs A.37855 Corporal Moon, J.A. surrendered himself to me at the Guard Room. I checked with the R.S.M. to see whether to place Corporal Meon, J.i. unfer place arrest or open arrest. Gerporal Meon was ordered unfer close arrest and held in the Guard Room.

Alemble 65 B. T7345 Corporal L Lamble, R.D.

The accused declines to cross-examine the witness.

The accused was cautioned as follows: "Do you wish to make any statement or to give evidence on Cath? You are not obliged to say anything or give evidence, unless you wish to do so, but whatever you say or any evidence you give, will be taken down in writing and may be given in evidence.

The accused declines to make a statement and reserves his defence.
