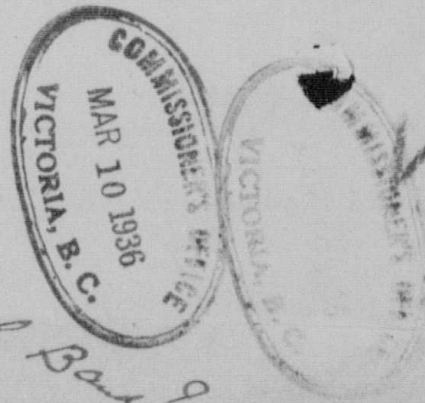
With reference to letter from Agent Halliday dated 25th May 1932 relating to Dead Point Indian reserve No.5 of the Village Island Indians, copy of which was forwarded to Mr. Ditchburn, as was also copy of departmental reply dated 9th June 1932, I have to advise you that surrender of the claim of the Mahmalilikullah band to the Dead Point I.R.No.5 in favour of the Tanateuk band was accepted and confirmed 5th July 1934.
