

the right to re-introduce it to the convention, provided a majority of the delegates present are favourable.

41. Committee on Ways and Means.

This committee shall consider the financial standing of the convention and recommend the per capita tax for the following year and also any extraordinary expenditure not provided for in the constitution.

42. Committee on Constitution and Law.

To this committee shall be handed all amendments to the constitution and laws of the Association for consideration, and report to the convention.

43. Committee on Procedure.

To decide on programme of the convention, and the priority of the resolutions.

The success of any Dominion convention depends on an open minded consideration by the delegates of the views, expressed on the floor of the convention, from all parts of Canada. Instructions by branches to delegates should not be in the form of hard and fixed resolutions precluding such consideration.

ARTICLE XI.

General Provisions

45. Procedure.

In matters not provided for in this constitution, or the constitution of a Provincial Command, or the by-laws of a local branch, all meetings shall be conducted on parliamentary lines.
