PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND.

Home Mission work on Prince Edward Island, from the formation of the Island Association until the present year, was conducted under the direction of the P. E. ISLAND BAPTIST HOME MISSIONARY SOCIETY.

At the seventh Annual Meeting of this Society, held at Charlottetown, on the 20th of July, 1874, it was unanimously resolved to unite with the Baptist Home Missionary Union of Nova Scotia, and to hand over to the officers of the Union all funds, papers, and property belonging to the Society, which then ceased to exist. Accordingly, no officers nor Board of Managers were elected for the ensuing year.

The Board reported but little Missionary labor performed on the Island during the past year,—two or three brethren only having been occupied as Missionaries for a few weeks in several localities.

The Treasurer's Account for the year ending July 21, 1874, shows the Total Receipts to have been \$284.63; Expenditures, for Missionary labor, \$272.50; Printing, Postage, &c., \$52.59; Balance on hand, \$127.24.
