- "2. Notwithstanding any thing contained in the thirty-eighth Time for drill. section of this Act, such days of drill need not be consecutive, unless so ordered by the Commander in Chief, who may also determine the manner in which such number of days of drill shall be computed."
- 7. The forty-third section of the said Act is hereby repealed Sect. 43 and the following section shall be substituted for it and bear repealed. the same number:
- "43. Each Sergeant Major of a Volunteer Field-Battery of Pay of certain Artillery shall, on account of the great responsibility attached officers. to the Office, be paid by the Province, at the rate of two hundred dollars per annum; and the Commander in Chief Instructors of Militia, apmay, from time to time, appoint musketry instructors, non-pointment. commissioned officers or other competent persons to be employed in drilling and instructing the officers, non-commissioned officers and men in the several Corps of Active and Sedentary Militia;

- "Each of such musketry instructors, non-commissioned Pay. officers and other competent persons so employed, shall be paid by the Province at a rate not exceeding one dollar and fifty cents per diem, when so employed."
- S. The Active Militia shall be paid on such proof of the Proof of perperformance of drill required by the said Act, at such times formance of and in such manner as the Commender in Chief man fund drill. and in such manner as the Commander in Chief may from time to time direct.
- 9. In time of Active Service in the field, and whenever the Pay of Militia Militia or any part thereof shall be called out by reason of called out for Active Service. invasion, insurrection or imminent danger thereof, the officers, non-commissioned officers and men of the Militia, so called out for Active Service, shall be paid at such rates of daily pay, and shall receive such allowances in every respect, as are paid and allowed to officers and men of the relative and corresponding rank or grade in Her Majesty's Army.

## CORPS FOR GENERAL SERVICE.
