" tioned," which agreement is as follows:

The faid Commissioners having met and communicated to each other their refpective powers, and authorities, and having taken into consideration and maturely deliberated upon the objects of their appointment, and finding that no material alteration hath taken place, in the relative situation of the two provinces, so as to require any change in the existing provisions for ascertaining the respective proportions of Duties and Allowance of Drawbacks on articles imported at the Port of Quebec, or otherwise: it is unanimously agreed, that the Articles of Agreement at present subfishing between the two Provinces be further continued, and be in force, as if they were here particularly inserted, until the first day of March in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nine. May it therefore please Your most Excellent Majesty, that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the " fourteenth year of his Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Ast for making more ef-

Provisional Articles ratified and continued. of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act pailed in the fourteenth year of his Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America," and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province;" And by the authority of the same, that all and every part of the said Provisional Agreement herein before particularly inserted, be ratisfied, approved and confirmed, and the same is hereby ratisfied, approved and confirmed accordingly.

II. And whereas an Act was passed in the thirty seventh year of Your Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act to ratify and confirm certain provisional Articles of " Agreement entered into by the respective Commissioners of this Province and of Up-" per Canada at Montreal, on the twenty eighth day of January one thousand seven "hundred and ninety seven, relative to Duties and for carrying the same into effect" which Act was continued to the first day of March one thousand eight hundred and one, and the faid Act was by another Act passed in the forty first year of Your Majesty's Reign, renewed and continued to the first day of March one thousand eight hundred and five; and it being expedient and necessary in pursuance of the herein before inserted provisional Agreement, that the said A& passed in the thirty leventh year of Your Majesty's Reign, should be further continued, Be it therefore enacted by the authority aforesaid, that all and every Clause, Obligation, Penalty, Fine, Forfeiture, Matter and Thing in the faid Act contained, and in the Provifional Articles of Agreement therein inserted, be continued, and the same and every part thereof, is and are hereby continued accordingly, and shall have the same effect, force and validity for and during the term of this Act, as if the same were herein particularly repeated and let forth.

Continuance of this Act.

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that this Act shall have force and effect, from the first day of March one thousand eight hundred and five, and shall continue to be in force to the first day of March, which will be in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and nine, and no longer.
