Esquire, to-wards aiding him to com geographical maps of the

ding Bouchette, the sum of five hundred pounds, current money of this Province, out of any unappropriated monies in the hands of the said Receiver General or which may graphical and hereafter come into his hands, and which have been or shall be levied or collected under any Act or Acts of the Legislature of the said Province, and that such sum Provinces of so issued, be towards aiding and assisting the said Joseph Bouchette in carrying into Lower Cana. effect his undertaking aforesaid.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the due application to be accounted for to the said monies pursuant to the direction of this Act, shall be accounted for to His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, through the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury for the time being, in such manner and form as His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors shall direct.

CAP. XX.

An Act to grant an aid to His Majesty, to assist in opening a Canal from the neighbourhood of Montreal to Lachine, and further to provide for facilitating the execution of the same.
