The House accordingly resolved itself into the said Committee.

Mr. Speaker left the Chair.

Mr. Bellet took the Chair of the Committee.

Mr. Speaker resumed the Chair.

And Mr. Bellet reported that the Committee had come to a resolution, which he was directed to submit to the House, whenever it shall be pleased to receive the same.

ORDERED, that the report be now received.

He accordingly read the report in his place, and afterwards delivered it in at the table, where it was again read by the Clerk.

The Resolution contained in the said Report is as followeth:

RESOLVED, That it is the opinion of this Committee, that the "Ordinance for quartering the troops upon certain occasions in the country parishes, and providing for the conveyance of effects belonging to Government," should be revised and amended.

- RESOLVED, That a Committee of five Members be appointed to report by bill or otherwise, such amendments, as it may be deemed necessary to make to the said Ordinance, agreeable to the said Resolution, with power to send for persons and papers.
- ORDERED, That Mr. Lee, Mr Taschereau, Mr. Cuthbert, Mr. Borgia and Mr. Bruneau do compose the said Committee.
