

The Bill presented to the House Yesterday, in Amendment of the Act relating to the Market, being ingross'd, was read a 3d Time.

Mr. *Burbidge* presented to the House (according to Order) a Bill intituled, *An Act to impower the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or Commander in Chief, to grant Warrants on the Treasury for a Sum not exceeding £1600. bearing Interest, for securing the Payment of the Expences of Government.*

And the said Bill having been committed accordingly, Mr. *Day* reported from the Committee, that they had gone through the Bill, and made several Amendments thereunto, and the said Amendments being read, were agreed to by the House,

*Ordered*, that the Message, [redacted] of the 27th Instant, and the Estimate of the Expence of Government form'd by his Excellency the Governor, and sent to this House, be read.

And the same were read accordingly.

*Resolved*, That a Message be sent to acquaint His Majesty's Council, 'That the House have taken into Consideration the Message of the 27th Instant, with the new Estimate form'd by His Excellency the Governor, to which Estimate the House have agreed, and are preparing a Bill to impower the Governor, Lieutenant-Governor, or Commander in Chief, to grant Warrants bearing Interest, for the Expence of Government, agreeable to said Estimate.'
