I. Be it Enaced by the Licutenant Governoz, Council and Affembly, That from and after the First Day of September next, until the First Day of June, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Three. Before any Wheat, Rye, Barley, Flour, Meal or Peafe, shall be laden or put on board any Ship, Vessel or Eoat, the Master of such Ship, Vessel or Boat, shall give Bond with one Surety, to the Naval Officer of the Diffrict, in double the Va- in this Province. lue of fuch Wheat, Rye, Barley, Flour, Meal or Peafe intended to be shipped, with Condition that the same shall be carried to some other Port or Place within this Province, (the Dangers of the Seas excepted) and to produce a Certificate of the due landing thereof, within Sir Months, under the Hand and Seal of the Naval Officer of the District, where the same shall be unladen or put on shore.

II. And be it Enaged, That if the Master of any Ship, Vessel or Boat, shall presume to receive on board the same any Wheat, Rye, Barley, Flour, Meal or Peafe (the Produce of this Province) before fuch Bond is given, fuch Master shall forfeit and pay the Sum of Twenty Pounds, and all such Wheat, Rye, Barley, Flour, Meal, or Peafe, so laden as aforesaid, shall be forseited, and shall and may be seized by any of his Majesty's Justices of the Peace, who are hereby impowered to feize the same.

III. Provided. That nothing in this Act shall be construed to debar any Person carrying Wheat, or other Grain, in any Boat passing the Rivers from one Town to another, or to or from Mill, or for the necessary Provision of the Vessel's Crew.

IV. And be it further Enaged, That for the Bond herein directed to be taken, and Certificate thereof, a Fee of Ewo Shillings shall be paid; and for a Certificate of the Landing of the Articles herein specified, a Fee of Dne Stilling shall be paid and no more.

V. And be it also Enaced, That the Forseitures incurred by this Act, shall be recovered, on the Oath of one Credible Witness, in any of His Majesty's Courts of Record in this Province; and after deducting the Expences of Profecution, be divided one Moiety to his Majesty, for the Use of the Government of this Province, and the other Moiety to him or them, who shall inform, seize or fue for the fame.

VI. And be it also surther Enacted, That where no Naval Officer shall be resident, the Bond herein directed to be taken, and Certificates to be given of the fame, and of the Landing thereof, shall be by one of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace of the Town or Place where the said Wheat, Rye Barley, Flour, Meal or Peafe, shall be loaded or landed.
