The Davis is the fastest on the Yukon and is used exclusively in the service of the government, carrying no freight or passengers. She was built for the Stickene river in 1899, but upon the Telegraph creek and Teslin lake route to the Klondike being pronouunced a failure she in company with Wyckoff was bought by the government and the following year both were towed up to St. Michael. Last year the Davis came up as far as Eagle, but has never yet visited Dawson or the upper river. The Wyckoff, which is used as a transport, is also en route up the river with freight for the different army posts. The Bella, Louise and Cudahy should also arrive


